


- 1) A) Place **bottom panel** onto a clean, padded surface. Attach 4 **legs** to **bottom panel** with 2 **large bolts**, 2 **spring washers** and 2 **large flat washers** per leg as shown. Secure, but do not over tighten, bolts using an **allen wrench.**
- B) Attach 1 bottom crossbar to bottom panel with 2 small bolts, 2 spring washers and 2 small flat washers as shown, using a phillips head screwdriver.
- C) Secure **bottom crossbar** to **bottom panel** with 1 **large screw**, using a screwdriver.




With the assistance of another adult, fit pre-assembled dowels of left/right side panels, left/right back panels and partition into corresponding holes of bottom panel. Secure bottom panel with 11 large screws, using a screwdriver.




3 Fit pre-assembled dowels of left/right side panels, left/right back panels and partition into corresponding holes of top panel. Attach top panel with 8 small bolts, 8 spring washers and 8 small flat washers as shown, using a screwdriver.




4) With the assistance of another adult, position assembled unit upright. Attach front frame to assembled unit with 12 small bolts, 12 spring washers and 12 small flat washers as shown, using a screwdriver.





- 5 Attach **back panel** to assembled unit with 14 **small screws** as shown, using a screwdriver.
- A) Insert 8 shelf pins at desired shelf heights.
 B) Place 2 adjustable shelves into assembly as shown.
 Make sure that each shelf securely supported by each shelf pin.



7 Push pins on top and bottom of **door front** down so that they are in the unlocked position. Fit **door front** into back groove of assembled unit. Push pins up to secure. Repeat for remaining door front using the front groove of unit.

Assembly is now complete.

CLEANING AND CARE

Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Do not use furniture wax or polish as the wood is finished with a protective clear lacquer.

SAFETY MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS:

For added safety and stability, it is recommended that the wall mounting hardware be installed. For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible.

- A) Attach 2 wall brackets to back of unit using 4 small screws as shown.
- B) Determine the final location of unit. Mark position on the wall, approximately 2" below each wall bracket mounted to the back of the unit.
- C) Drill a hole in the wall stud. If the wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Gently tap the **plastic anchor** until the flange of the anchor is flush with the wall.
- D) Attach wall brackets to the wall by inserting 2 large screws through each bracket and each plastic anchor in the wall.
- E) Place the unit so the wall brackets on the back edge are aligned with the wall brackets on the wall.
- F) Lace one end of the **wall straps** through each bracket, and into the other end of the strap.
- G) Pull the strap tightly until secure. Wall mounting assembly is now complete.



NOTE:

If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.
