Note: 2 people are required to safely assemble this product.

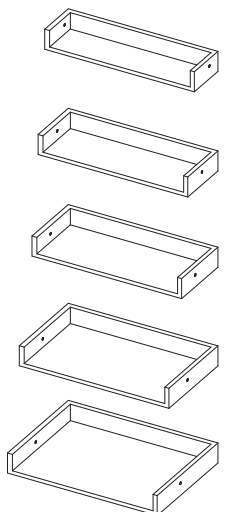

## COMPONENTS BOX 1

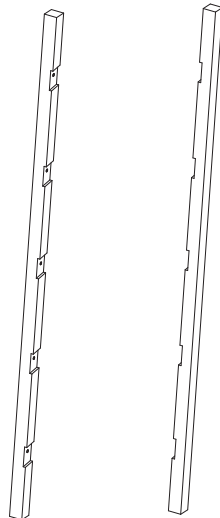


5 - shelves

1 - bottom crossbar

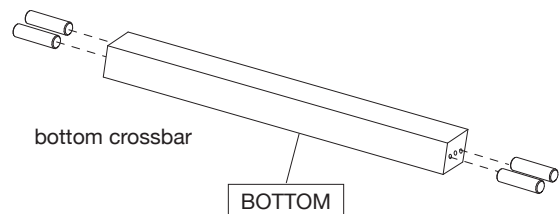
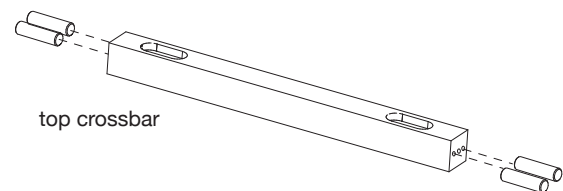
1 - top crossbar

1 - right upright



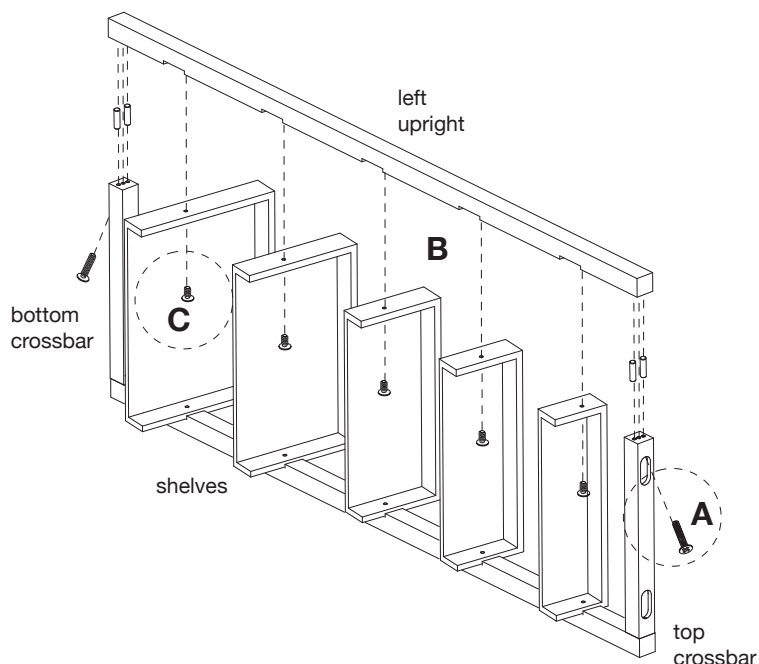
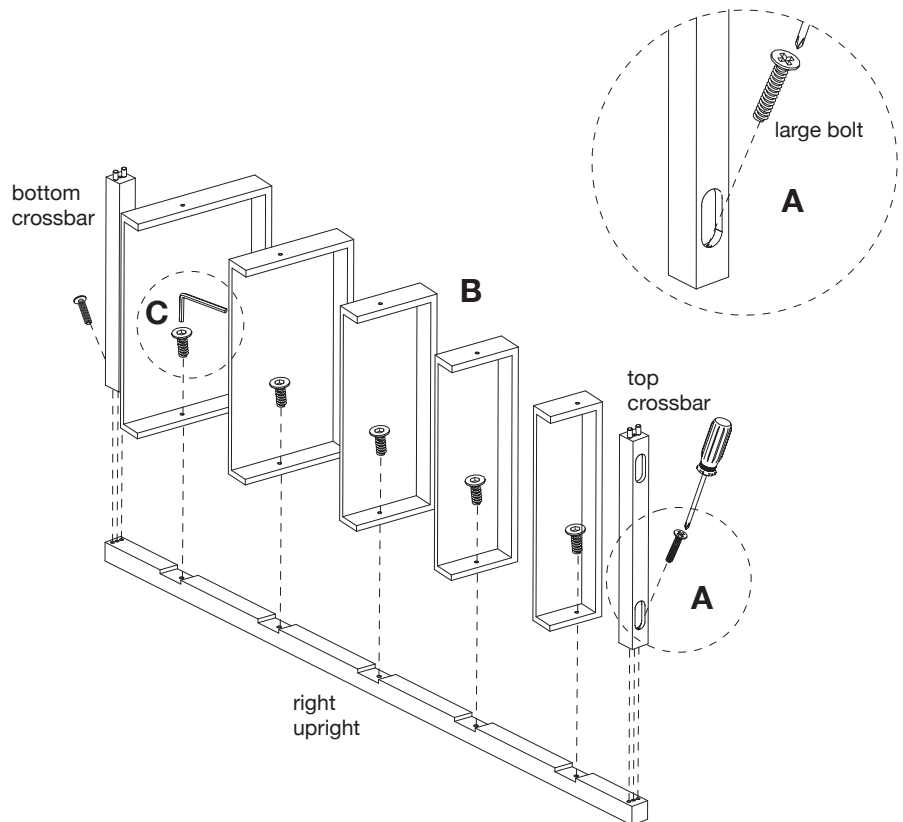
NOTE: Bottom crossbar is indicated as shown.

① Insert 8 **wood dowels** into **top and bottom crossbars** as shown.

② A) Fit dowels of **crossbars** into **right upright** as shown. Make sure top and bottom crossbars are assembled in the appropriate location. Secure each crossbar with 1 **large bolt** as shown, using a **phillips head screwdriver**.

B) Position **right upright** with 5 **shelves** (in descending depths) as shown. Place the shortest depth shelf at the top of the uprights, and longest depth shelf at the bottom.

C) Insert 1 **small bolt** through each shelf side, and secure each screw with an **allen wrench**.



③ A) Fit dowels of **crossbars** into **left upright**. Secure each crossbar with 1 **large bolt** as shown, using a **phillips head screwdriver**.

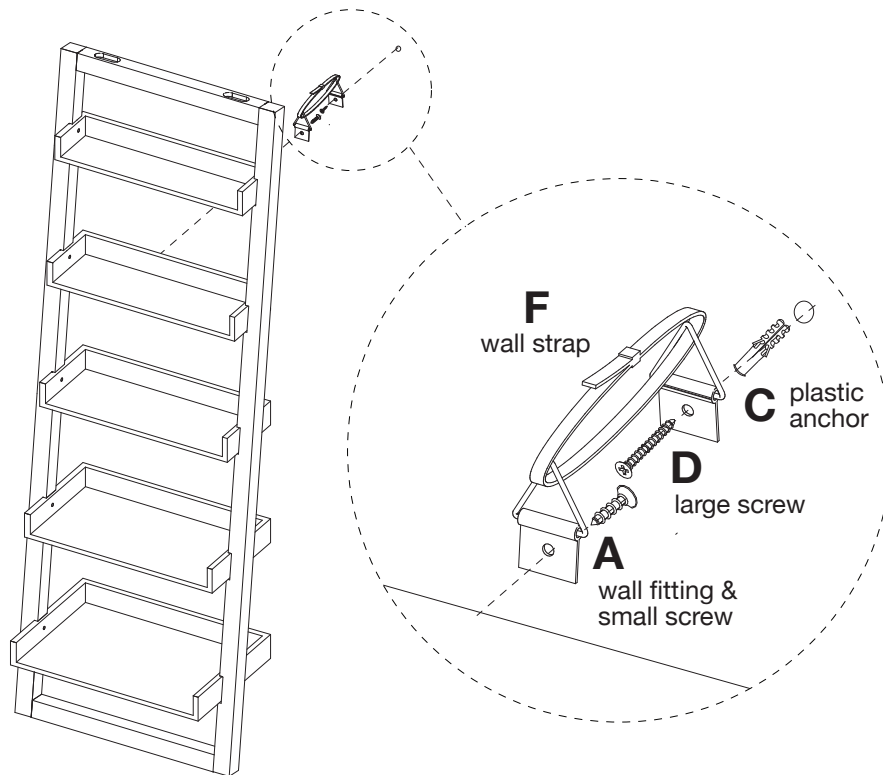
B) Position **left upright** with 5 **shelves** as shown.

C) Insert 1 **small bolt** through each shelf side, and secure each screw with an **allen wrench**. Position unit upright.

Assembly is now complete.

## CLEANING AND CARE

Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.



## SAFETY MOUNTING ASSEMBLY

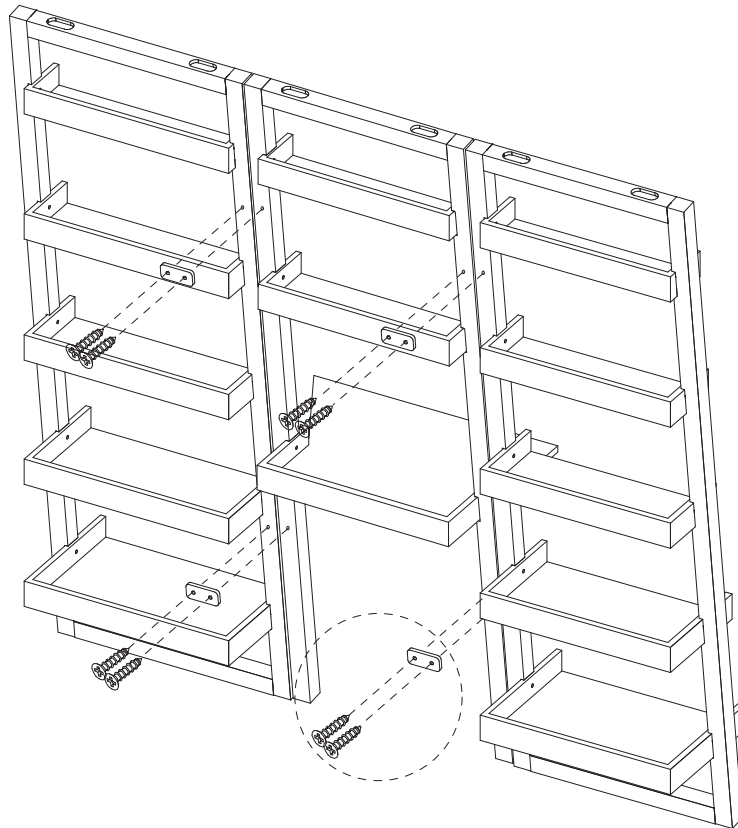
For added safety and stability, it is recommended that the wall mounting hardware be installed. For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible.

- A) Attach 1 **wall fitting** to assembled unit as shown, using 1 **small screw**.
- B) Determine the final location of shelving unit. Mark position on the wall, approximately 2" below the bracket mounted to the back of the unit.
- C) Drill a hole in the wall stud. If the wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Gently tap the **plastic anchor** until the flange of the anchor is flush with the wall.
- D) Attach the **wall fitting** to the wall by inserting 1 **large screw** through the wall fitting and into the plastic anchor in the wall.
- E) Place the unit so the wall fitting on the back edge is aligned with the wall fitting on wall.
- F) Lace one end of the **wall strap** through both fittings, and into the other end of the strap.
- G) Pull the strap tightly until secure.

Mounting assembly is now complete.

## NOTE:

**If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.**



## MULTIPLE LEANING SHELVES/DESK ASSEMBLY

If you purchased multiple leaning items, it is suggested that every two or more item be secured together. As shown, connect every 2 units with 2 **connecting plates**. Attach each plate with 2 **medium screws** using a screwdriver. Repeat steps for each additional leaning unit item.
