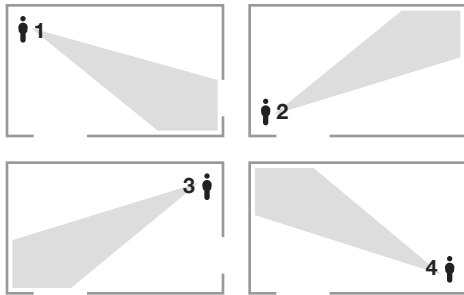
In this guide, we'll show you how to collect photos and detailed measurements of your space so we can create your design plan. You'll need a camera, measuring tape and pencil nearby.

take photos of your space

Let's get a look at your whole room. Bright light is key, so switch on lamps and open shades before you start snapping. Remember, the room's floor and ceiling should be visible in every photo.

Corner Photos (Step 1)



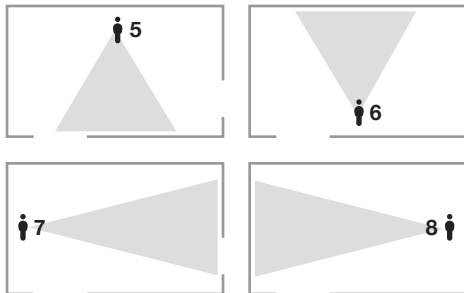
STEP 1

Stand in each corner of the room, facing into the room. Point your camera toward the opposite corner of the room, getting as much of the space in the frame as you can. Make sure you can see both the ceiling and floor in the shot, then take the photo.

STEP 2

Stand in the center of each wall of your room, facing straight ahead. Point your camera at the opposite wall and take the photo.

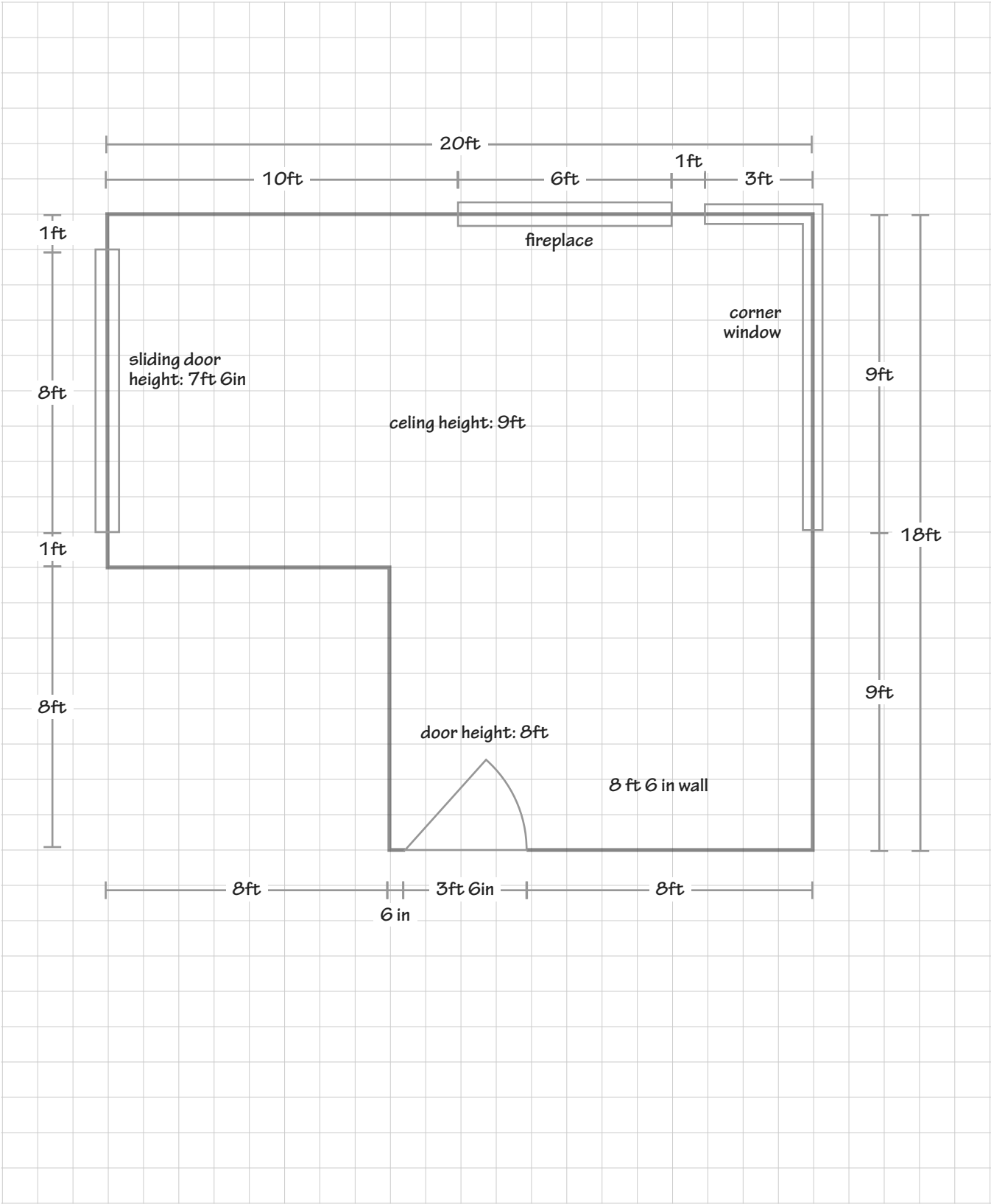
Wall Photos (Step 2)
